La Castanyada (The Chestnut Festival) is celebrated on the 31st of October in Catalonia. People eat roasted chestnuts traditionally wrapped in newspaper, called 'paperina', marzipan sweets called 'panellets' and sweet potatoes called 'moniatos' and drink 'moscatell'.









The legend says that the tradition originated years ago when bell ringers had to work all night in churches to warn the neighbours of the coming time to pray for the deceased. Due to the exhausting activity of ringing the bells all night long, the bell ringers are chestnuts and sweet wine to gain forces.





'Castanyeres' are women dressed up in peasant's clothing and wearing a headscarf.



Children celebrate la Castanyada' at their schools.

Their mums dress up as 'castanyeres' and roast chestnuts for them. They also sing traditional songs and dance traditional dances.

ARTICLE 14

RIGHT TO THOUGHT AND EXPRESS AN OPINION

FRANCE

This year, our class has been selected to participate in the National event "Children's Parliament" . The subject is "equality between men and women".

For 577 classes (years 6), it is about understanding how the legislative power works in France.

Each class makes an inventory of the situation and proposes a law of 4 articles.

We meet our politic representative Mrs Limon on January 17 for an interview and to gather his advice in order to improve our proposal.

In March, only 1 class by French Academy will be chosen by a professional political jury.

In april, only 4 proposals will be chosen.

On may, each class will vote for it favorite proposal. The 4th winner classes will be received in Paris in the National Assembly, in the Bourbon Palace. 1 will be granted by the National Education Minister.

The winner proposal can be accepted and voted by the Assembly.

Child labor is therefore taken into account by the government.

Here is our Law proposal:

"Law proposition Aiming to combat gender stereotypes and create real equality between men and women from an early age."

France, country of the Enlightenment, known in the world for the Universal Declaration of Human and Citizen Rights, has for motto "Liberty, equality, fraternity". In this sense, one might think that equality between men and women has been acquired for a long time. Everyone must be able to have the same rights, the same possibilities to build their life, despite their differences. However, despite the Declaration of the Rights of the women written in 1793 by Olympe de Gouges (it was guillotined besides), France does not accept that in 1944 the right to vote to the women long after New Zealand, Finland and the Norway. According to the report "Towards real equality between men and women" 2019 requested by Mrs. Marlène Schiappa, France is world champion of equality (elected by the World Bank). However, according to a survey created and conducted by our class with more than 100 people (parents, middle school students, teachers, students), we still live in a stereotypical France and ignorant of existing laws. Pink for girls, blue for boys, girls 'games, boys' games are still in store today. The

professions of girls "nurse, midwife, mistress ..." and the professions of boys "mason, firefighter, doctor, author ...", hobbies for girls "dance, music, creative hobbies ..." and hobbies for boys "cars, trucks, football, rugby... "predestined the children.

What boy wants to be a midwife? " a little girl ".
Which girl wants to play rugby? " a tomboy ".

Perhaps it is time to change, including at the level of the French language? Did you know that women earn 9% less for equal work than men? Did you know that only 7% of women's sports are broadcast on television? That girls between the ages of 14 and 20 drop out of sport massively? Did you know that only 10% of the people questioned in our survey know Olympe de Gouges or other famous women? If you imagine a scientist, it is the image of a man who appears: Einstein,

If you imagine a scientist, it is the image of a man who appears: Einstein, Leonardo da Vinci, the mad scientist ...

These stereotypes are everywhere. Ignorance of the laws (1965: right to work without the authorization of her husband, 1972: for equal work, equal pay; 2000: law on parity...), the ignorance of great female models prevent French society from advancing towards a logical and natural equality between men and women, towards a Modern France.

Online members.

For each of us to dare to be equal, we must start from childhood.

Article 1

We mediate the law of mixed representation of toys. We multiply the checks at the big brands of toy or childcare stores (fine). Play areas, playgrounds must be redesigned in public and educational places (nursery, daycare, school, etc.).

Article 2

From nursery school, French students are educated in a more mixed sports, cultural and scientific environment with images of female models. Large portrait posters are displayed in schools.

In at least one of the three years of each following cycle, great female characters from French or international history are studied.


Article 3

In the citizen journey of French students, we integrate:

- In year 4-5-6, learning about women's rights and the laws that defend equality
- In middle and high school, learning about the possible sanctions incurred in the event of discrimination (hiring, salary, etc.), verbal or physical violence.

Article 4

On public channels, we increase the media coverage by 30% by 2024 (television, internet) of major female sports competitions. We're increasing the interview time for female champions on sports broadcasts. We are developing programs on artistic sports.



We worked about right to expression: gender equality. We wrote our ideas for French students in the forum.

We received our local political representative, deputy Mrs. Limon Friday January 17 as part of our work for the Children's Parliament and the bill that we wrote "For real equality between women and men from childhood".

She gaves us advices to improve our law proposal.

She explained her politician mission.

We explained our project about the Rights of the Child. She was very interested.

It was a great citizenship experience.







Spanish Healthcare System

Spain has an extensive network of health centres and hospitals throughout the country.

In Spain there are two kinds of healthcare systems: the private and the public.

The public system provides free basic healthcare to those who contribute to the Spanish social security system and their families. The public system also provides free healthcare for retirees.

Everybody has got an Individual health card which provides the social security number.

Foreign employees working for Spanish companies or self-employed foreigners in Spain usually have to contribute to Spanish social security (seguridad social). This entitles them and their families to receive free or subsidised medical care on the same terms as Spanish residents.

If you are not a pensioner, employed person or officially a resident in Spain you will not qualify for free medical treatment under the Spanish public system. Residents in Spain should ensure they are covered by private medical insurance if the Spanish security system does not cover them.

Spain has also got an excellent system of private medicine and in recent years has become more important because as with the state systems in other European countries there can be long waiting lists to see specialists and for non-emergency surgical care.

In the case of an emergency, go straight to the nearest casualty department (urgencias). Under Spanish law any health organisation, public or private, is required to treat patients in an emergency situation regardless of their insurance status.

For minor ailments, there are local pharmacies (farmacias), which have a green flashing cross displayed outside or in the window. They take turns to provide a 24-hour service, and display their schedules in the window – or in the local paper. Pharmacists in Spain provide treatment advice for many common illnesses and ailments.

The event took place in the school yard. There was a band playing music.






The teachers sold hot chocolate with sponge fingers and the students at school did arts and crafts and sold them for a few euros. All the money we collected goes to the hospital for the research.



The 5th graders also did "bracelets Candela" and sold them for 3€ and 5€. The bracelets are very popular and they are called Candela because of a girl who had leukaemia.





The history of this Association and its beautiful bracelets began in 2013 and it is the story of a girl, Candela, admitted to the Hospital Sant Joan de Déu for leukaemia.


On the days she was at the 8th floor of Onco-hematology, a hospital volunteer taught her how to make colourful thread bracelets.

Some years later, some friends of Candela, decided to open a little shop in their town in which they made and sold the bracelets they named Candela's Bracelets.

The money they raised was given to childhood cancer research.

This great idea was successful, so other families and friends began to run little shops to produce the bracelets in order to help research.

All donations collected go directly to the research laboratories of the Hospital Sant Joan de Déu in Esplugues (Barcelona).

THE FOOD BANK FOUNDATION

The Food Bank Foundation is a network of NGOs (non - governmental organizations) whose purpose is to avoid waste by recovering surpluses of food suitable for human consumption and fighting against poverty, by delivering them to people in a situation of food precariousness in our environment.

In Catalonia we have a food bank in each province. Food is provided free of charge through recognized charities, in order to contribute to sustainability.



There are 3 classrooms: 79 students to 7 years old to 11 years old.

We haven't got gymnasium for Physical Education but we have a large field and a



tarmac handball field in the village.

3) In our class, we have only 1 teacher for 27 students.

Her name is Mrs Aurélie Saunier.

She's the headteacher of the school too.

She teaches us all the subjects: MATHS (6 hours by week: operations, geometry, measure, problems solving...), FRENCH (7 hours by week: grammar, tenses, vocabulary, spelling, writing and reading, speaking, poetry..), ENGLISH (1hour and a half by week), SCIENCES, history of ARTS, HISTORY OF FRANCE, GEOGRAPHY (France, Europe, World), Arts (music, singing, drawing...), PHYSICAL EDUCATION, CIVIC MORAL EDUCATION (live together, become a good citizen...).

= 22 hours + 2 hours (break time) = 24 hours by week = monday, tuesday, thursday, friday.

Each day: 8.20 AM to 11.30 AM (15 minutes break time in the morning), 11.30 to 1.05 pm = lunch time at home or canteen at school, 1.15 to 4.05 pm.


Each year, we celebrate the Light day. It was to thank Virgin Mary to protect Lyon from the illness.







But our teacher has prepared groups challenges in reading and spelling activities about Olympic and paralympic games....


With all those activities, we understand that everyone has the Right to play and everyone has skills and can developp them.




UNICEF acts all over the world to help children and mother.

JANUSZ KORCZAK, THE FORERUNNER OF CHILDREN'S RIGHTS

Léa , Marie and Lou present their poster of Janusz Korczak, the forerunner of Children's Rights.



Here is his story:



" Janucz was born in Warsaw Poland in 1878 in a jewish family.

He studied in a sad school where children was bitten if they made mistackes or if they didn't understand something.

When his father died, he had to work and earn money.

He taught to children of wealthy families. But when he came back home, he met poor children, "children of the Street".

He decided to teach them in the Street. He brought objects and told them stories.

Children created stories with these objects.

He wrote books but he became doctor and cured in a jewish hospital for children because the 1st Right is "to be cured".

In 1910, he founded a orphanage for jewish children.



There was a lot of violence between all the children. He made a Children Parliament to help to calm violence and write laws. Violence disappeared little by little. 1914: 1st WORLD WAR. He had to fight for the russian army as a doctor.

When he came back , he opened a 2nd orphanage and wrote stories like "King Mathias 1st".

He fought for Children's Rights and in 1924, the first Children's Rights declaration was born.

He created a NewsPaper. Journalists were only children because for him, children have the Right to express themselves.


1933 : Hitler and the Nazis.

They wanted to kill Jews.

1942 : Janusz did not abandon them and accompanied them in a concentration camp in Treblink, a death camp.


They died together!




